- In view of this, the Schools Division Office supports the following guidelines: 3.
 - Promotion of Membership to the Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts of the Philippines;
 - Membership Fees Campaigns
 - Strengthening Quality Scouting Program;
 - Participation of DepEd Officials, Personnel and School Children in Scouting Activities;
 - Institutional Support; ٠
 - Wearing of Scout Uniforms; and •
 - Giving of Service Credits, Other Credits for Awards Received and Trainings Attended and Other Incentives.
 - 4. With this note, there will be a simultaneous opening program on October 3, 2022 in celebration of Scouting Month during Flag Raising Ceremony.
 - 5. Other suggested activities are the following:

 - Wearing of Scout Uniforms every Thursday Conduct of 1 hour scouting related activities like Scouting Ideals, Scouting songs, yells, etc.
