In compliance with DepEd Memorandum OUFGO No. 2022-03-024, dated August 15, 2022 and Regional Memorandum No. 1102, s. 2022 dated September 29, 2022 re: Strengthening School Health Support for SY 2022-2023, with the theme : "Pinalakas na Oplan sa Kalusugan sa DepEd, Pinatatag sa Health Learning Institutions", this office, through the Schools Governance and Operation Division – Health and Nutrition Unit (SGOD-HNU) advice all schools of Schools Division of Calbayog City to Celebrate the One Health Week Celebration. This Activity is suggested to be celebrated this week Nov. 2-4, 2022. Suggested activities for the celebration are the following:

- a. Kick-off activity for the celebration of One Health Week
- b. Handwashing and toothbrushing activities.
- c. Updating of Nutritional Status of learners
- d. School-Based Cascading of ARH orientation
- e. Updating of NDEP corner and submission of NDEP Monthly Report
- **f.** Any Activities in relation to implementation of Six (6) Flagship Program (School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP), Wash in School (WINs), Adolescents Reproductive Health (ARH), Mental Health, National Drug Education Program (NDEP), Medical, Dental and Nursing Services of Oplan Kalusugan sa DcpEd (OK sa DepEd).
- 2. Classes shall not be interrupted during the one Health Week Celebration

3. Schools shall submit narrative and pictorial report on the activities conducted in relation to the Oplan Kalusugan One Health Week Celebration.
