 - 6.3 exemplify good conduct, proper values, and attitude inherent to sports as a means for learning good citizenship; and
 - 6.4 identify athletes, coaches, and chaperons of the various sports events who will represent Eastern Visayas to the 2023 Palarong Pambansa.
- 7. The conduct of all sports competition shall be guided by the following enclosures:

- 8. In this connection, all official CCAA Delegation participants will stay at PALO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, Palo, Leyte from April 21-28, 2023.
- 9. All concerned CCAA Delegation will meet on April 21, 2023 at Calbayog City Sports Center at exactly 9:00 AM for the departure to Palo, Leyte. AM Snack, Lunch and PM Snack will be given before departure while dinner will be served in the billeting school at Palo National High School, Palo, Leyte. Departure of CCAA delegation to Calbayog City will be on April 28, 2023 at exact 7:00 AM.
- 10. In view thereof, this office requests that all concerned personnel and learners listed in the attached enclosure shall be excused from their classes on April 20-28, 2023. It is understood that arrangements will be made for the classes of those athletes, giving them consideration in the submission of subject requirements like projects and giving them special examination if they failed to do so because of conflict of schedule with the concentration training and participation in the 2023 EVRAA Meet.
- 11. In the same manner, arrangements will also be made for the classes of those teacher- coaches to be handled by other teachers in their respective schools.
- 12. All sports officials listed in the attached enclosure must adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 (DepEd Child Protection Policy). As such all officials shall be held responsible for the protection of student-athletes from abuse, violence, exploitation, discrimination, bullying and other forms of abuse. All officials are reminded also to take precautionary

- All athletes should bring with them their own eating utensils, sets of bedding, personal belongings and enough clothing for the whole duration of the concentration training.
- 14. Coaches, chaperons and trainers are also required to provide their own sets of bedding.
- Service Credits/CTO shall be granted to the participants who will render services on days that fall on weekends and holidays as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 67, s. 1988 and CSC Memo Circular No. 09, s. 1988.
