RO8 stirs EVRAA '23 Solidarity Confab, underscores new rules, venues

Tacloban City- Thronged by coaches, assistant coaches, chaperones, officiating officials, tournament managers, SDOs Key Personnel, and Region 8 Officials, the Solidarity Conference marked the official dash of the 2023 Eastern Visayas Regional Athletic Association (EVRAA) Meet, Leyte Sports Development Center, April 23, Sunday.

In his opening lines, Dr. Ronelo Al K. Firmo, CESO V, Assistant Regional Director, stressed the slew of changes in the rules and format in conformity with the Palarong Pambansa guidelines. Eastern Visayas is grouped with Western Visayas (Region 6), Central Visayas (Region 7), and Region 9 (Zamboanga Peninsula).
