'Golden Boy' Jomar Lapara notches 1st EVRAA 2 Gold Medals in Gymnastics by Cristian L. Senolos



Calbayognon gymnast Jomar Labonite Lapara seized the gold medals in floor exercise and vault apparatus dominating the 13 divisions, 30 competing individuals in Men's Artistic Gymnastics Secondary in Leyte National High School Gymnatorium, Tacloban City, Tuesday.

Calbayog Supersonics Boxing Team secured its place as bronze medalists in Junior Boys Pin Weight, Light Fly, and Bantam categories in the semi-finals yesterday, April 25, 2023 at Pawing Gymnatorium, Palo, Leyte.

Kian Sambalilo, a 15-year old boxer of Calbayog City, bested Tacloban and Biliran in Junior Boys Pin Weight Category with his excellent jabs, hooks, bobs and weaves, and counter punches resulting to walk-over and split decisions with 10,9 scores. In the semi-finals, Sambalilo was down for the count in his match against a herculean boxer from Ormoc City resulting to referee stops contest (RSC) verdict.

Releasing power jabs, uppercuts, hooks, and tricky pivoting, Albert Ortoguero outsmart

Policarpo National High School. He once won the 2019 Eastern Visayas Regional Athletic Association (EVRAA) Meet gold medal in MAG when he was a Grade 5 gymnast.

Attesting his prowess in gymnastics, Lapara topped the floor exercise, his first gold medal in MAG competition, where he scored the highest points 12.140 from the judges in nipping John Patrick B. Loreto of Baybay City, who settled for the silver with 12.040 points while Jomar Quindao of Leyte Division placed third with a total of 11.870.

Coming off a victory in vault apparatus, Lapara averaged 11.600 after gracing the gymnatorium in awe with a breathtaking winning routine
