- 1. In reference to the Regional Memorandum No. 674, series of 2024, the division thru the Curriculum implementation Division (CID) will conduct the Workshop on the Development of Lessons Scripts and Expert Validation for the National Reading Program (NRP), National Mathematics Program (NMP), and Catch-Up Fridays (CUF) on July 2-12, 2024 and Workshop on the Finalization of Lesson Scripts for NMP, NRP, and CUF on July 15-19, 2024 in a venue to be announced later thru a separate memorandum.
