**IMPLEMENTATION OF JOINT DELIVERY VOUCHER PROGRAM (JDVP) FOR
SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL-LIVELIHOOD (TVL)
SPECIALIZATIONS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025**

1. This office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), announces the implementation of the Joint Delivery Voucher Program (JDVP) for the School Year 2024-2025 from November 4 to December 13, 2024.
2. The primary objective of the program is to enhance the capability of DepEd Senior High Schools (SHSs) to implement the TVL track through partnership with partner institutions that are equipped with necessary resources to carry out the program. Specifically, the JDVP-TVL aims to;
 - a. Enable learners to complete their respective TVL specialization subjects through the JDVP-TVL Partners;
 - b. Provide an appropriate learning environment required of the specialization; and
 - c. Address delays in the provision of the necessary resources for TVL specialization.
3. The number of slots allotted to the respective implementing schools are the following:

4. To complete the required 320 hours or 40 days of TVL specialization training for School Year 2024-2025, Blended Learning Modality will be utilized, which includes Face-to-Face training on weekdays, and Modular Approach on Saturdays and Sundays.


5. The JDVP implementing schools shall manage on the SHS TVL learners enrolled in the program can still comply with the other subjects while engaged in the TVL specialization training.
