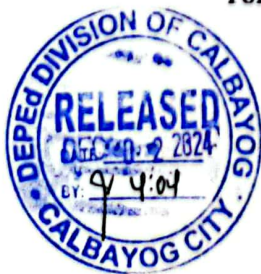
EXTENSION OF THE CONDUCT OF SCHOOL-BASED IMMUNIZATION

1. The conduct of School-Based Immunization to all Grade 1, Grade 4 (female), and Grade 7 learners started on November 4, 2024. As per information from the Department of Health (DOH) and Calbayog City Health Office (CHO), SDO Calbayog City has a very low coverage of immunization. Therefore, SBI will be extended up to December 20, 2024.
2. Further, all schools are requested to have their Masterlist of SBI beneficiaries with consent duly signed by the parents ready-available at their respective schools. DOH team of vaccinators will be visiting the schools for the actual vaccination from December 6 to 20, 2024.

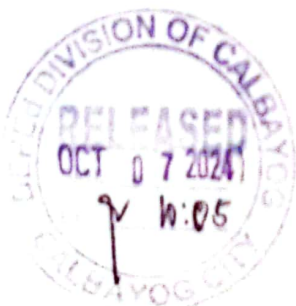

**RESUMPTION OF SCHOOL-BASED IMMUNIZATION**

All Others Concerned

1. Per DepEd Memo DM-OUOPS-2024-03-06789 titled Interim Guidelines on the resumption of School-Based Immunization (SBI) program dated August 19, 2024, and DOH DM Order No. 2024-0250 dated June 21, 2024 which is the full resumption of face-to-face classes which exposes school learners to high risk of contracting Vaccine Preventable Diseases (VPD), thus, the School-Based Immunization Program shall be implemented and shifted back to the usual routine immunization schedule/procedures.
2. In view thereof, this office hereby requests the required data to be prepared and submitted. See attached forms to be filled-up.
3. Further, the school is directed to submit a copy of the Recording Forms 1 and 2 to the nearest Health Center of your school. The list of health center will be announced through the SGOD-School Heads official group chat. Each adviser must have a copy of all forms ready and available during the actual immunization.
4. Deadline of submission of forms to health center near your school is on or before Oct. 28, 2024 for data inclusion and logistic requirements in respective health center.
