### ANNEX C

## Objective

The Department of Education promotes zero-tolerance policy for any act of child abuse, exploitation, violence, discrimination, bullying and other forms of abuse.

## **Principles**

- Schools shall be conductive to learning and children shall have the rights to education free from fear;
- All children shall be protected from all forms of abuse and bullying to develop self-esteem and self-confidence;
- Schools shall advocate a positive and non-violent mode of disciplining children to foster self-discipline and to improve self-esteem;
- Corporal punishment shall not be imposed on any child in school for the purpose of discipline, training or control;
- School Heads shall take steps to prevent bullying an ensure that the appropriate interventions, counselling and other services, are provided for the victims of abuse, violence, exploitation, discrimination and bullying;
- Pupils, students or learners shall respect the rights of others and refrain from committing acts of bullying and peer violence;
- Parents shall be actively involved in all school activities or events that raise awareness on children's rights, positive discipline, and the prevention of bullying;
- 8. Visitors and guest shall be oriented on the Child Protection Policy;
- All schools shall establish a Child Protection Committee (CPC) which shall be composed of the following members:
  - a. School Head/ Administrator Chairperson
  - b. Guidance Counselor/ Teacher Vice Chairperson
  - c. Representative of the Teachers as designate by the Faculty Club
  - d. Representative of the Parents as designated by the Parents-Teachers
    Association
  - e. Representative of pupils, students and learners as designated by the Supreme Student Council Representative from the Community as designated by the Punong Barangay, preferably a member of the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC).
