#### ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL ACHEIVEMENT TEST FOR GRADE 6 FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025

- 1. Pursuant to DO 024 s. 2025, this good office through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) of the Department of Education hereby informs the field on the administration of National Achievement Test for the current Grade 6 learners comes April 3, 2025.
- 2. The said exit assessment is aimed to validate whether the Grade 6 learners were able to meet the learning standards for elementary curriculum. Further, the said assessment shall cover 5 learning areas in a paper and pencil modality namely: English, Filipino, Mathematics, Science and Araling Panlipunan.
- 3. In accordance to DO 27, s. 2022 titled Conduct of Rapid Assessment in School Year 2021-2022 for Learning Recovery as well as in Preparation for the 2024 Baseline System Assessment, the said assessment shall cover all Grade 6 learners of the current school year from both public and private elementary schools operating with permit.
- 4. Further, to ensure smooth conduct of the test, an orientation meeting shall be conducted on March 28, 2025, 8 AM at the Division Conference Hall.
  - 5. The following shall be discussed during the orientation:







#### ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST FOR GRADE 6 FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2024–2025

- The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) will administer the National Achievement Test for Grade 6 (NATG6) for school year (SY) 2024-2025, pursuant to DepEd Order (DO) No. 55, s. 2016 titled Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program on March 31 and April 1-4, 2025, as testing window to public and private elementary schools operating with a permit.
- 2. The conduct of the test is pursuant to DO 009, s. 2024 titled Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2024–2025.
- 3. In accordance with DO 027, s. 2022 titled Conduct of Rapid Assessment in School Year 2021–2022 for Learning Recovery as well as in Preparation for the 2024 Baseline System Assessment, the current Grade 6 learners of the present SY will be taking the test.
- 4. The **NATG6** will be administered on a paper-based modality to all regional offices (ROs), schools division offices (SDOs), public elementary schools, and private schools operating with permits.
- 5. The **NATG6** is an exit assessment that is designed to determine if Grade 6 learners are meeting the learning standards in the elementary curriculum. The test design measures five learning areas (English, Mathematics, Science, Filipino, and Araling Panlipunan) in a multiple-choice format.
- 6. The Language of Testing for the following learning areas are as follows:

Language of Testing	Learning Areas
English	English, Science, and Mathematics
Filipino	Filipino and Araling Panlipunan

- The BEA will conduct a virtual orientation for Regional Testing Coordinators, Division Testing Coordinators, and SDO Private School Supervisors on the test administration. The schedule and meeting details will be sent in a separate Advisory.
- The BEA will manage the national implementation of the NATG6 with the assistance of the ROs and SDOs.
- Learners with disabilities may also be assessed provided that the test accommodations stipulated in Section 9 of DO 55, s. 2016 are met.
- Health and safety protocols must be followed in all activities related to the national test administration.
- An authorized forwarder will deliver and retrieve the test materials to and from the SDOs.
