We will follow strict guidelines in compliance with RA 10173 or the Data Privacy Act of 2012 to ensure that your child will be protected at all times. However, should your child choose to share personal information, this information will be considered in confidence by the organizer and documenter.
- (ii) The event may be documented through photos, videos, audio recordings, and notetaking to capture valuable insights and ideas. Your child will be asked for permission to be photographed or recorded. They can also be interviewed during the training. They can opt-out at any time and their wishes will be respected.
- (iii) Your child will not be paid for participating in the training.

SRHR PEER EDUCATION TRAINING

Baypark Hotel, Calbayog City, Samar / August 15-17, 2025

Dear Participant,

We look forward to your active participation in our upcoming live-out training. To ensure your comfort and preparedness throughout the training sessions, please read the following items:

- Jurisdiction Participants shall read, understand, and obey the rules and guidelines
 of the training. They shall respect the authority of the LGU Calbayog City and its
 partners.
- Conformity to Values participants shall uphold a good value to their self and to others.
- 3. Emergency Care Participants shall bring their own medicines. LGU Calbayog City will arrange with the management of the venue for the health care service provider solely for the purposes of first aid throughout the duration of the SRHR Peer Education Training. In case a participant needs to avail of hospital services, expenses shall be borne by the participant concerned.
- 4. Proper Attire Participants shall wear the prescribed attire for the training. During sessions, the prescribed attire for both males and females (T-shirt, long pant, sneakers or rubber shoes and socks) shall be worn. Participants are prohibited from wearing short pants, slippers, and jewelleries. The management of the venue and LGU Calbayog City shall not be responsible for any loss.
- What to Bring Participants shall may bring the following: Reusable Water Bottle/ Tumbler, Face Mask and Hand Sanitizer, Sweater or Jacket, Extra Shirts, Umbrella or Raincoat. No need to bring gadgets. Most importantly; PARENTS/ GUARDIANS CONSENT.
- 6. Prohibited Acts Participants shall not commit the following: not wearing of ID, texting and calling during sessions and activities, non-silencing of mobile phones, arriving late, talking loud or shouting, cursing or saying bad words, absence during sessions and activities, smoking, neglect causing damage to supplies and property, throwing garbage, non wearing of the prescribed attire, conduct unbecoming such as petting, kissing, and cuddling, gossiping, lying and backbiting; leaving the venue without approval, bringing of dangerous objects (expulsion), holding of protests or rallies leading to public disorder (expulsion), use of prohibited substance (expulsion), theft (expulsion) and bullying (expulsion).
- 7. Meals Breakfast, lunch, dinner, and two snacks will be provided during the training hours. As this is a live-in training, all participants are expected to remain within the hotel premises and refrain from going outside to purchase food or other materials.


