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4. The Regional Office and the host Division may likewise invite stakeholders and volunteers who shall participate in the kick off program and in the repair, beautification, and clean-up activities.

5. All participants are expected to bring with them anything that they can donate to the host school. The handover of donations shall form part of the program. They shall likewise bring with them repair and cleaning tools. The Division Partnership Focal Person shall coordinate with the host Division for the priority needs of the schools assigned to them and for their respective assignments in the repair, beautification, and clean-up drive.

6. All Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are hereby directed to conduct their respective Division-level *Brigada Eskwela* Kick-Off Ceremonies subsequent to the conclusion of the Regional Kick-Off Program. The implementation of both the Division Kick-Off activities and the actual conduct of *Brigada Eskwela* at the school level shall be subject to monitoring and technical assistance by the Regional Field Technical Assistance Composite Teams (RFTACTs). 8. The Division Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) Focal Person of the visiting Schools Division Office (SDO) shall be responsible for the facilitation of the Anti-



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Bullying Session in the identified schools during the conduct of simultaneous sessions. The Regional LRP Focal shall provide the necessary session guides and presentation materials, including PowerPoint presentations, to ensure uniformity and compliance with prescribed content and standards.

9. The Medical Officers of the host school and/or Schools Division Office (SDO) are hereby requested to conduct the requisite health screening procedures in accordance with existing health and safety protocols.

10. The participants of the Regional Kick-off shall be provided with meals (breakfast, lunch and two snacks) which shall be shouldered by the Local Government Unit (LGU), while the travel expenses shall be charged to their respective local fund/MOOE/Partnership Fund subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

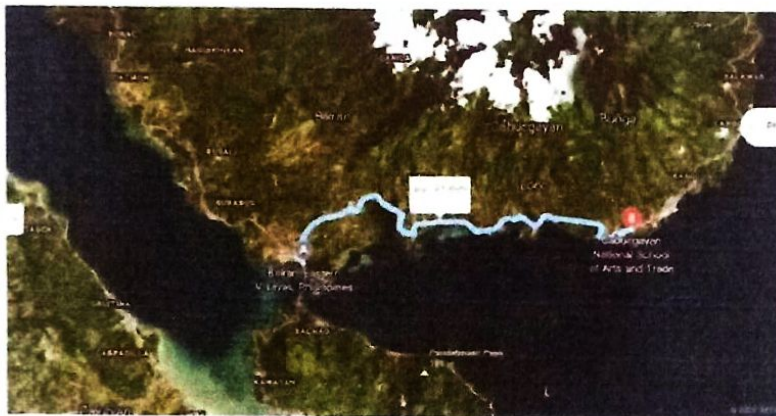
