1. This is to **update** the information provided in **DM No. 327, s. 2025**, particularly the **billeting assignment of one school**. Instead of **Matobato Elementary School**, the billeting assignment is now designated to **Bagacay Integrated School** under the supervision of District Calbayog 2. This adjustment is in line with the **final list of LGU contingents and their partner schools** for the Tandaya Festival of Festivals.

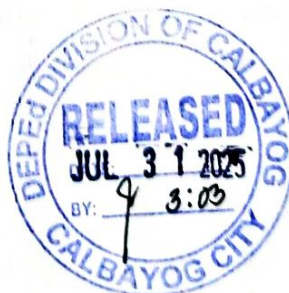

4. Security and maintenance personnel will also be deployed by the Provincial Government to assist in maintaining peace and order, as well as post-use clean-up.

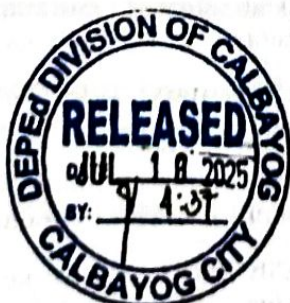

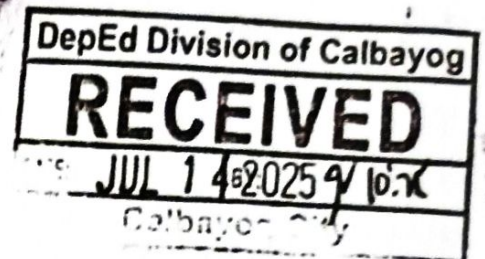
