The DepEd Order No. 021, s. 2019, also known as "Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of K to 12 Basic Education Program" represents a holistic approach to education, focusing on integrating the Core Values (*Maka-Diyos, Maka-tao, Makakalikasan, and Makabansa*), across all grade levels and subjects. These values are central to DepEd's vision of developing Filipinos who are passionate about their country, possess the necessary skills and values to reach their full potential, and contribute to nation-building. Hence, the selected pilot schools are instructed for the **"PLANNING CONFERENCE FOR CURRICULUM MAPPING ON THE ADOPTION AND PILOT INTEGRATION OF "ONE VALUES PROGRAM (OVP)" OF THE PROVINCE OF SAMAR TO THE HOMEROOM GUIDANCE PROGRAM OF GRADE 1 TO GRADE 10 LEARNERS** on **August 27, 2025; 8:00 am** at the **Division Conference Hall** to be participated by the implementors below and program committee members.

2. The program was the initiative of the Province of Samar to promote and preserve the values and culture of Samar. This aims to create value-driven character communities among families, puroks, barangays, municipalities, and cities. Specifically, it aims to:

- a. To formulate a value system for Samaritans that will serve as an anchor for sustainable development and good governance efforts.
- b. To establish a highly participative implementation structure that operationalizes the concepts of development from "inside-out", and the principle that progress of communities is everyone's responsibility.
- c. To be at the forefront of launching the Global Compact on Education (GCE) in the Province of Samar.



In OVP Program activities that are conducted during holidays and weekends (such as orientation, meetings, etc.), the participants who rendered services can avail of the service credit, CTO, or COC equivalent to eight hours of service per day whichever is applicable per DepEd Order No. 67, s. 1988 and CSC Memo Circular No. 09, s. 1988.

8. Expenses relative to implementation and integration of the program shall be charged against Support Fund from the Province or School MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
