2. This will be spearheaded by the Division Math Core Group composed of the different district math coordinators to ensure smooth implementation of the said activity.

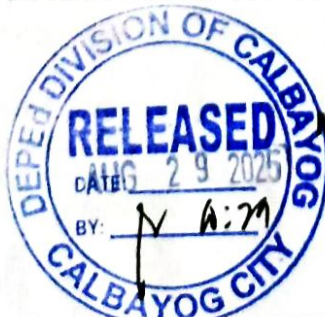
3. The following are the contest categories, to wit:

ACTIVITY / TRAINING PROPOSAL

I. Title: **HOSTING OF 2025 PROVINCIAL STATISTICS CONTEST**

II. RATIONALE:

October is celebrated as the statistics month in the Philippines. The celebration is spearheaded specifically by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) being the central statistics arm of the government.

With the issuance of PSA Memorandum Circular No. 2025-08, all agencies of the government, academic institutions, and state universities among others are enjoined to actively participate in and support the 36th National Statistics Month (NSM) celebration. The theme for this year's celebration is: **"Accelerating the SDG Pace of Progress: Mobilizing Data for All"**.

The annual observance of the NSM is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647, "Declaring the Month of October of Every Year as the National Statistics Month," issued on 20 September 1990 by then President Corazon C. Aquino.

The observance of the NSM will be highlighted by a diverse range of month-long statistical activities. Every PSA office, bureau or branch will have its own lined-up activities. For the PSA Samar Provincial Office, one of the activities to be conducted is the Inter-Division Statistical Contest under which there are four specific categories namely: the extemporaneous speaking, slogan-making, poster-making, and the statistics quiz. Today's Inter-Division Statistical Contest will be hosted by Schools Division of Calbayog City.

III. OBJECTIVES:

The main objective of this activity is to showcase student's talents and skills while promoting camaraderie and healthy competition among students.

IV. PARTICIPANTS:

The participants of this activity are the student-contestants and their coaches, select PSA and DepEd personnel.,

V. PROCEDURE / METHODOLOGY:

The activity will be done with the usual opening program for preliminaries. Then each contest category will be conducted by each group of contest officials following the guidelines and mechanics for each category. The afterwards declaration and awarding of winners will follow during the closing program.


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
