



REGIONAL CELEBRATION OF THE WORLD TEACHERS' DAY

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 067, s. 2025 dated 11 August 2025, titled "2025 National Teachers' Month, National Teachers' Day, and World Teachers' Day Celebrations," which enjoins all DepEd officials, teaching, and non-teaching personnel nationwide to participate in the month-long observance of National Teachers' Month (September 5 to October 5, 2025) and the culminating National Teachers' Day and World Teachers' Day on October 5, 2025, this Office shall spearhead the **Regional Celebration of World Teachers' Day on 19 September 2025** at the **Leyte Academic Center, Palo, Leyte**, to be hosted by the Schools Division of Leyte.
