CONTEST GUIDELINES

Eligibility

- Candidates must be licensed professional teachers or non-teaching personnel (with professional teacher license) officially employed under the Schools Division of Calbayog City.
- Each cluster must field four (4) representatives:
 - 1 Male
 - 1 Female
 - 1 Gav
 - 1 Lesbian

Representation

- Clusters are responsible for the preparation, grooming, and support of their official candidates.
- Substitution of candidates is only allowed one week before the coronation day with official endorsement from the cluster head.

Behavior and Conduct

- Candidates must display professionalism and sportsmanship at all times.
- Any misconduct or violation of DepEd Code of Ethics may lead to disqualification.

Attire and Materials

- Clusters are responsible for the preparation of their candidates' costumes, attires, and props.
- Costumes and concepts must remain decent and respectful of cultural and professional values.

Judging and Criteria

- Candidates shall be evaluated by an independent panel of judges invited by the Division Office.
- Judges' decisions are final and irrevocable.

MECHANICS PER SEGMENT

1. Fantasy Costume Competition

- Each candidate will showcase a creative fantasy costume symbolizing the theme: "Teachers as Light of Sidlangan".
- Candidates must prepare a 30-second self-introduction during the ramp walk.

Criteria:

Creativity, originality, and artistry -40% Relevance to theme -30% Stage presence and confidence -20% Audience impact -10%Total: 100%

2. Talent Presentation (Group by Cluster)

- Each cluster will prepare a 5-minute maximum group presentation.
- Acceptable formats: dance, music, skit, spoken word, or mixed performance.

Props and music must be coordinated with the program committee two days prior.
