Greetings!

As provided for in RA 10121, one of the known DRRM mechanisms that we can use as a tool in providing directions concentrated in the response phase after a disaster is Contingency Planning. It is used to establish preparedness measures and arrange response priorities ahead of time prior to a certain disaster. Contingency planning works well together with other DRRM tools to help ensure the achievement of safer, adaptive and disaster-resilient communities towards sustainable development.

Moreover, RDRRMC Resolution No. 06-003 series of 2025, dated June 25, 2025, directs all Local Government Units to formulate Contingency Plans for Earthquake and Rain-Induced Hazards based on worst-case scenarios highlighting evacuation spots.

Considering that the province has 2 cities and 24 municipalities, the current number of trainers trained on Contingency Planning will not suffice the demand for technical assistance from the local government units. Hence, the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office, in partnership with the Office of Civil Defense RO8 and DRAGONS, initiated the conduct of CONTINGENCY PLANNING TRAINING OF TRAINORS scheduled this August 4 – 8, 2025 at Red Iron Hotel, Calbayog City, Samar.

With this, we would like to invite MS. CARREN MERYL A. CABADSAN to be one of the participants for the above-mentioned activity. He/she will be a good addition to the pool of trainers for the Contingency Planning within the province.
