**HEARTS THAT PROTECT: PROJECT KALINGA TRAINING ON LEARNER
 SAFETY AND SPIRITUAL NURTURING**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Children today face complex challenges such as bullying, abuse, violence, neglect, and exploitation. While existing legal frameworks mandate the protection of learners, the reality in schools demands a more holistic response that addresses not only safety but also the emotional, moral, and spiritual resilience of children. Hence, the birth of Project KALINGA (Knowledge, Advocacy, Love and Compassion, Inclusivity, Non-Violence, Gratitude, and Awareness), which introduces a transformative approach by weaving spiritual values into the core of learner protection. It recognizes that safe schools are not just policy-driven but are also anchored in compassion, mindfulness, and the promotion of a culture of belonging.
2. In view thereof, this Region, through the Special Programs and Projects Section (SPPS) shall conduct the **Hearts that Protect: Project KALINGA Training on Learner Safety and Spiritual Nurturing** on November 4-7, 2025. The specific venue shall be announced later through a separate Advisory.
3. This training program seeks to strengthen the capacities of teachers, school heads, and Child Protection Committee (CPC) members in protecting children through a blend of legal compliance, psychosocial support, and spirituality integration. It will empower educators and leaders not just as enforcers of policy, but as guardians of compassion and role models of non-violence.
