

As part of the Viseyes Leg of the Philippine Butch Workshop Series, the Kepws Movement and Goethe Institut, in cooperation with the Northwest Semer State University and the City Arts and Culture Office, will conduct the *Punia at Binhi Project* for Eastern Viseyes on November 28, 2625 at 8:00AM at the Celbeyog Sports Complex in Calbeyog City, Samer.

Punta at Binhi is a capacity-building initiative and community mapping project that brings Butch into regional communities through a lecture-workshop tour. This is the first national effort of its kind to plant the seeds of a locally grounded Butch network in the Philippines, and it also serves as a preparatory movement toward the Asia Butch Gathering 2026. The project aims to:
