7. For your guidance, information, and strict compliance.

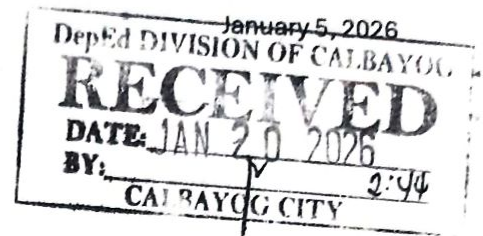

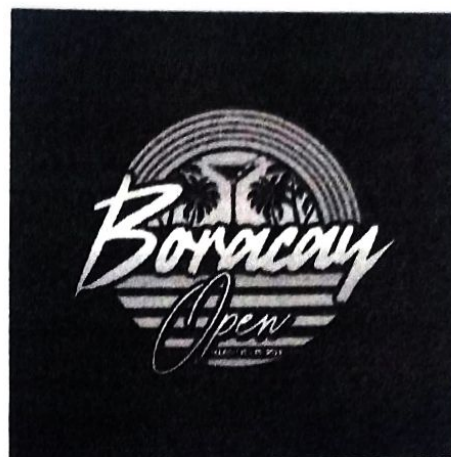
