**CONDUCT OF BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES (BSP) CALBAYOG CITY
COUNCIL SCOUTING ACTIVITIES FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2026**

1. Consistent with the goal of strengthening the Scouting program in this Division and promoting leadership, discipline, and the core values of citizenship among learners, this Office announces, per letter received, that the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) Calbayog City Council will conduct a series of Scouting activities this February 2026.

2. The schedule of activities and their respective venues are as follows:

3. The activities are open to **all registered KID, KAB, Boy, and Senior Scouts**, as well as **Kawan Leaders, Troop Leaders, Outfit Advisors, and Institutional Scouting Coordinators** from both public and private schools.

4. To ensure the safety and organized conduct of the events, all participating scouts must comply with the following:


a. Must be currently registered with the BSP Calbayog City Council;

- b. Submission of a duly accomplished Parent's Consent Form;
 - c. Submission of a Medical Certificate signed by a legitimate medical practitioner;
 - d. Wearing of the prescribed Type "A" or "B" Boy Scout Uniform; and
 - e. Provision of personal emergency kits, hygiene kits, food, and necessary camping gear/equipment.
5. **Participation Guidelines:**
- a. **KID/KAB/Boy Scouts:** A minimum of eight (8) scouts and one (1) Adult Leader per patrol; and
 - b. **Senior Scouts (Jamborette):** A minimum of 36 scouts and one (1) Outfit Advisor per outfit.
6. Expenses for the **registration fees** shall be used to cover participation certificates, activity materials, souvenirs, and logistics. These may be charged against local school funds/MOOE or other available sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. School Heads are reminded to ensure that the **"No Disruption of Classes" policy** is observed and that necessary arrangements are made for the safety and child protection of all participants in accordance with existing DepEd policies.
8. For immediate dissemination and compliance.

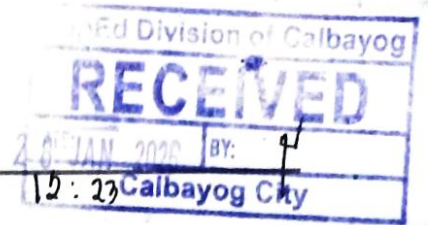




