DEPARTURE FOR THE 2026 EASTERN VISAYAS REGIONAL ATHLETIC
ASSOCIATION (EVRAA) MEET**

1. In line with the preparation for the Calbayog City Delegation's participation in the 2026 Eastern Visayas Regional Athletic Association (EVRAA) Meet to be held in Baybay City, Leyte, from March 1-7, 2026, this Office hereby announces the **extension of the athletes' SDP: school-based concentration training by two (2) additional days**. This extension aims to enhance the athletes' readiness, refine skills, and ensure optimal performance at the regional level.
2. The original concentration training schedule (February 18-23, 2026) is hereby extended from **February 24-25, 2026**. All participating athletes, coaches, chaperons, and support staff are required to report to the designated training venue during this period. Training sessions will focus on advanced drills, team building, nutritional guidance, and mental conditioning.
3. In addition, preparations for the delegation's departure to Baybay City shall commence immediately following the extended training. Departure from Calbayog City to Baybay City on February 26, 2026, via coordinated bus transport.
4. All school heads are directed to extend full support to the involved athletes and personnel, including the release from regular duties without

disruption to school operations. Compensatory time-off or service credits shall be granted in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003.

5. Expenses incidental to this activity, such as meals, supplies, and transportation, shall be charged against the school MOOE and/or other available local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
