**CONDUCT OF 2026 COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES
CALBAYOG CITY COUNCIL**

1. Pursuant to the request of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) Calbayog City Council and in reference to BSP Regional Memorandum No. 13, s. 2026, this Office announces the conduct of the 2026 Council Scout Youth Forum on February 27–March 01, 2026, at San Joaquin National High School, Calbayog City.

2. The activity aims to:

- a. Develop leadership, communication, and decision-making skills among Senior Scouts;
- b. Provide a venue for Scouts to raise concerns and propose solutions;
- c. Formulate youth-led resolutions for Council consideration;
- d. Elect Youth Representatives to higher-level Scout Youth Forums; and
- e. Promote active citizenship and community engagement.

3. Each participating secondary school is requested to send three (3) voting and two (2) observing registered delegates, and one (1) registered adult adviser, subject to qualifications set by the BSP Calbayog City Council.

4. Participants shall bring provision-in-kind food, a complete Type A Scout Uniform, and other required materials. Expenses relative to participation, such as transportation and incidental expenses, shall be charged against local scouting funds, MOOE, SEF, or other available funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. The duly elected Council Scout Youth Leaders shall officially represent the Council in the Regional Scout Youth Forum scheduled on March 20–22, 2026, at Capitol Hills Scout Camp, Cebu City, subject to compliance with the requirements and guidelines set by the organizing body.

6. Grant of Service Credits. Teachers who shall serve as official adult advisers, coordinators, facilitators, or members of the working committees during the conduct of this activity on non-working days shall be entitled to service credits, subject to existing DepEd rules and regulations on the grant of service credits

(e.g., DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, and other related issuances). The grant of service credits shall be based on actual services rendered, duly certified by the Council Chairman/Activity Head, and recommended by the School Head for approval by this Office.

7. School Heads are hereby directed to extend full administrative and supervisory support to the activity, ensure proper supervision and monitoring of participating Scouts, and strictly observe the "No Disruption of Classes Policy." They shall likewise ensure that appropriate safety measures are in place and that all activities adhere to existing DepEd policies on child protection and safeguarding, to promote the welfare, security, and well-being of all learners involved.

8. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

SUBJECT: **2026 REGIONAL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM**

1. The Eastern Visayas Region, BSP announces the conduct of the **2026 Regional Scout Youth Forum** with details as follows:

Date: 20-22 March 2026
Venue: Capitol Hills Scout Camp, Cebu City
Host: Cebu Council, BSP

2. The Scout Youth Forum is a primordial part of the Youth Development Program of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines and is organized to fill in the need and the clamor for more Youth Participation in the decision-making processes in the Scout Movement, especially in matters and issues directly affecting them, and serves as a laboratory for the development of leadership from among our young Scouts.


Voting Delegates of the Regional Scout Youth Forum shall elect six (6) Voting Delegates to the National Scout Youth Forum, including two (2) Scout Representatives to the Regional Scout Committee.

3. **Forum Rules and Regulations.** The conduct of the Regional Scout Youth Forum shall be governed by the Updated and Revised Scout Youth Forum Guidelines 2023 as approved by the National Executive Board last 24 March 2023 and stipulated in **National Office Memorandum No. 37 s. 2023.**
4. **Participation.** There shall be three (3) Voting Delegates, two (2) Observers, and one (1) Accompanying Adult per Local Council to attend the Regional Scout Youth Forum. Local Councils are required to accomplish and submit the **List of Participants** using the attached form to evrco@scouts.gov.ph **on or before 06 March 2026.**
5. **Qualifications.** Participants must possess the following qualifications:
For Senior Scouts:
 - Must be a currently registered Senior Scout;
 - Must be between 14-18 years old;
 - Must be at least Outdoorsman rank; and
 - For Voting Delegates, must be elected during the Council Scout Youth Forum.


For Accompanying Adults:

- Must be a currently registered Adult Leader;
- Must have been officially designated by the Local Council; and
- Must be fully conversant about the Scout Youth Forum.

6. **Registration Fee.** A registration fee of **TWO THOUSAND PESOS (Php 2,000.00)** shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for accommodation, meals (from breakfast of 19 March 2026 to lunch of 22 March 2026), materials, souvenirs and other administrative costs.
7. All expenses such as registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses on this travel shall be chargeable against scouting funds/local funds/MOOE/SEF, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. **Things to Bring.** Participants are advised to bring the following: Type A Scout Uniform (Long Pants); Smart Casual Clothes for Socials, Laptop, Forum Reference Materials, Vitamins and Medicines (if any).
