PARTICIPATION IN THE FIRE PREVENTION MONTH 2026 CONTEST

1. In line with the month-long observance of Fire Prevention Month 2026 and pursuant to the communication from the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) – Calbayog City Fire Station, this Division encourages the participation of schools and higher education institutions in various contests aimed at promoting fire safety awareness and community preparedness among learners.

2. As part of the Community Relations Week (COMRES) of the BFP Calbayog City Fire Station, the following contests shall be conducted:

a. **Digital Art Contest**

– Open to **Senior High School** and College Students

b. **Poster-Making Contest**

– **Elementary and Junior High School Category**

c. **Essay Writing Contest**

– Open to **Senior High School** and College Students

d. **Hot Shots 2: The Quiz Bee Battle**

– College Students

3. All contest entries must clearly illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the official Fire Prevention Month 2026 theme: **“HANGAD NATING LAHAT, PAMAYANANG HANDA, AKTIBO AT MASAGANA”**

4. The contests, originally scheduled to be held at the Reynaldo S. Uy Socio-Cultural Center, NWSSU, shall instead be conducted through submission and judging of entries due to the unavailability of the venue. Participating schools and institutions are requested to submit their official entries to the: Bureau of Fire Protection – Calbayog City Fire Station on March 10, 2026, at 8:00 A.M., for proper

evaluation and judging by the designated Board of Judges. Winning entries from each Fire Station in BFP West Samar shall undergo further evaluation by the Provincial Committees, where one (1) entry per contest shall be selected to represent the Province of Samar at the Regional Level. The contest mechanics and detailed schedule are attached to the BFP communication for guidance and reference.
