**DISSEMINATION OF COUNCIL CIRCULAR NO. 2, S. 2026 AND VR
CIRCULAR NO. 2, S. 2026 RE: VISAYAS REGIONAL JUNIOR,
SENIOR AND CADET CAMP**

1. For the information and guidance of all concerned, attached is a copy of Council Circular No. 2, Series 2026 from the Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) Calbayog City Council, dated February 20, 2026, and VRO Circular No. 2, s. 2026 from the GSP Visayas Region, dated February 2, 2026, announcing the schedule of the **Regional Junior, Senior and Cadet Camp on March 22-26, 2026** at the Marina Yulo-Vargas Regional Program and Training Center (MYVRPTC), Barangay Kalunasan, Cebu City.
2. The event carries the theme "**EmpowHER to Act: Cultivating LeadHERship for Lasting Change.**" It is open to registered Junior, Senior, and Cadet Girl Scouts who meet the specified qualifications, including physical fitness certification, earned badges (Environment, Preparedness, Arts, Heritage & Citizenship), and adult leaders with required certifications.
3. Participation details include:
 - a. **Junior Participants:** Minimum of four (4) patrols of 8 girls with two (2) adult leaders per council.
 - b. **Senior Participants:** Minimum of four (4) patrols of 8 girls with one (1) adult leader per council.
 - c. **Registration Fee:** ₱7,000.00 per camper (broken down as: Camp Fee ₱3,500.00; Fare ₱2,600.00 Calbayog-Cebu-Calbayog; Food ₱700.00 at ₱100.00 a day; Miscellaneous ₱200.00 Pre-Camp to Pier).
 - d. **Schedule:** Pre-Camp at 8:00 AM on March 19, 2026; Departure at 3:00 PM on March 19, 2026.

- e. **Activities:** Emergency Preparedness, Adventure Games, Arts and Crafts, Protecting the Vulnerable, Awareness on Human Trafficking, Swimming, Campfire, Scout's Own (for Juniors); Actual First Aid Session, Free Being Me, Mural Painting, Rappelling, Martial Arts, Council Extravaganza, Campfire, Scout's Own and Tour (for Seniors).
 - f. **Things to Bring:** Individual items such as two (2) sets of official uniforms with complete GS paraphernalia and GS Cap; two (2) sets of camp uniforms with green socks, closed black shoes, rubber shoes, slipper, and shoe polish kit; comfortable working clothes; sleeping garments (preferably pajamas); Several changes of underwear; face and bath towels; casual dress; native costume; physical fitness outfit denim pants; art materials; medical certificate and parent's consent; rain coat; outdoor bedding – oil cloth and blanket; bedrolls/sleeping bag; GS knife; flashlights; water canteen/plastic tumblers; sit-upon; sewing kit; writing materials; set of eating utensils; 1 set of patrol equipment including tent, fly tent, cooking utensils, water jug/container, pails/dippers, basin, materials for light gadget, bolo/trowel, broom stick, Kaper's Chart, plastic bag (large) for litters, first aid kit, kerosene lantern/emergency lamp, and contingents list.
4. A physical re-check will be conducted upon arrival at camp, and participants must bring their individual Health Form and Parent's Consent Form. All troop leaders are required to ensure compliance with health and safety protocols.
5. School heads are directed to disseminate this information to qualified Girl Scouts and adult leaders in their respective schools. **Participation in this activity is voluntary and shall be on official time only for DepEd personnel, subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005.**
6. For inquiries, contact the GSP Calbayog City Council through Council Executive Marlene D. Talana or Council President Esther S. Santianez. Further, for the interested participants, kindly coordinate with the GSP Council Executive and Council President mentioned above.






