RE: 2026 REGIONAL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM**

1. Attached are Regional Memorandum No. 327, s. 2026 from the Department of Education (DepEd) Regional Office VIII – Eastern Visayas, and BSP Regional Memoranda Nos. 13, s. 2026 from the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) Eastern Visayas Regional Coordination Office, announcing the conduct of the **2026 Regional Scout Youth Forum on March 20-22, 2026**, at **Capitol Hills Scout Camp, Lahug, Cebu City**, hosted by the Cebu Council, BSP.

2. The Scout Youth Forum is a key component of the BSP Youth Development Program. It addresses the need for greater youth participation in decision-making within the Scout Movement, particularly on issues affecting them. It serves as a leadership laboratory for young Scouts and includes the election of six (6) Voting Delegates to the National Scout Youth Forum, including two (2) Scout Representatives to the Regional Scout Committee.

3. Relative to DepEd and DILG issuances supporting BSP activities, all concerned schools are encouraged to facilitate the participation of qualified Senior Scouts and designated Accompanying Adult Leaders from their respective institutions, in coordination with the Division BSP Coordinator and school-based Scout leaders.

4. Key details from the attached BSP Regional Memorandum No. 13, s. 2026, include:

4.1 **Participation per Local Council:** Three (3) Voting Delegates, two (2) Observers, and one (1) Accompanying Adult.

4.2 **Qualifications for Senior Scouts (Voting Delegates/Observers):**

- Must be a currently registered Senior Scout;
- Must be between 14-18 years old;
- Must be at least Outdoorsman rank; and
- For Voting Delegates: Elected during the Council Scout Youth Forum.

4.3 **Qualifications for Accompanying Adults:**

- Must be a currently registered Adult Leader;
- Must have been officially designated by the Local Council; and
- Must be fully conversant with the Scout Youth Forum.

4.4 **Registration Fee:** A registration fee of **TWO THOUSAND PESOS** (Php 2,000.00) shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for accommodation, meals from breakfast of March 19, 2026 to lunch of March 22, 2026, materials, souvenirs, and administrative costs.

4.5 **Participation:** Participants are advised to bring the following: Type A Scout Uniform (long pants), smart casual clothes for socials, laptop (if needed), forum reference materials, vitamins/medicines (if any).

4.6 **Submission of List of Participants:** List of Participants (using the attached form) shall be submitted to evrco@scouts.gov.ph as soon as possible per instructions from the Regional Scouting Coordinator, Dr. Reynaldo E. Nayre.

4.7 **Governing Guidelines:** Updated and Revised Scout Youth Forum Guidelines 2023 (National Office Memorandum No. 37 s. 2023).

5. All expenses such as registration fee, transportation, and incidentals) shall be chargeable against Scouting/BSP funds, local funds, MOOE/SEF, subject to availability and usual accounting/auditing rules and regulations.

6. The general program of activities includes arrival/settling-in on March 19, 2026; opening/integration/team building on March 20, 2026; plenary sessions/discussions/resolutions on March 21, 2026; and closing/elections on March 22, 2026 (refer to the attached program for full details).

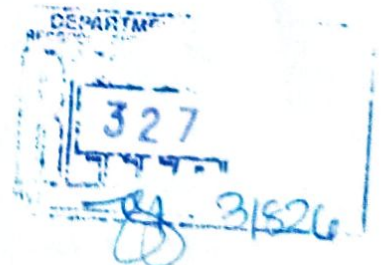

SUBJECT: **2026 REGIONAL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM**

1. The Eastern Visayas Region, BSP announces the conduct of the **2026 Regional Scout Youth Forum** with details as follows:

Date: 20-22 March 2026
 Venue: Capitol Hills Scout Camp, Cebu City
 Host: Cebu Council, BSP

2. The Scout Youth Forum is a primordial part of the Youth Development Program of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines and is organized to fill in the need and the clamor for more Youth Participation in the decision-making processes in the Scout Movement, especially in matters and issues directly affecting them, and serves as a laboratory for the development of leadership from among our young Scouts.

Voting Delegates of the Regional Scout Youth Forum shall elect six (6) Voting Delegates to the National Scout Youth Forum, including two (2) Scout Representatives to the Regional Scout Committee.

3. **Forum Rules and Regulations.** The conduct of the Regional Scout Youth Forum shall be governed by the Updated and Revised Scout Youth Forum Guidelines 2023 as approved by the National Executive Board last 24 March 2023 and stipulated in **National Office Memorandum No. 37 s. 2023.**
4. **Participation.** There shall be three (3) Voting Delegates, two (2) Observers, and one (1) Accompanying Adult per Local Council to attend the Regional Scout Youth Forum. Local Councils are required to accomplish and submit the **List of Participants** using the attached form to evrco@scouts.gov.ph **on or before 06 March 2026.**
5. **Qualifications.** Participants must possess the following qualifications:

For Senior Scouts:

- Must be a currently registered Senior Scout;
- Must be between 14-18 years old;
- Must be at least Outdoorsman rank; and
- For Voting Delegates, must be elected during the Council Scout Youth Forum.

For Accompanying Adults:

- Must be a currently registered Adult Leader;
- Must have been officially designated by the Local Council; and
- Must be fully conversant about the Scout Youth Forum.

6. **Registration Fee.** A registration fee of **TWO THOUSAND PESOS (Php 2,000.00)** shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for accommodation, meals (from breakfast of 19 March 2026 to lunch of 22 March 2026), materials, souvenirs and other administrative costs.
7. All expenses such as registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses on this travel shall be chargeable against scouting funds/local funds/MOOE/SEF, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. **Things to Bring.** Participants are advised to bring the following: Type A Scout Uniform (Long Pants); Smart Casual Clothes for Socials, Laptop, Forum Reference Materials, Vitamins and Medicines (if any).
