2. The activity aims to equip adult leaders with advanced skills in humanitarian action planning, certify official BSP trainers for emergency-related merit badges, and align BSP initiatives with national disaster risk reduction frameworks like RA 10121.
3. The details of the activity are as follows:
 - *Date:* June 6–15, 2026
 - *Venue:* PDRRMO Grounds, San Jose, Antique
 - *Host:* Antique Council, BSP
 - *Registration Fee:* Twelve Thousand Pesos (Php 12,000.00) per participant
4. Below are the participant requirements and criteria:
 - A total of 30 scout leaders will be selected across the region.
 - Must be a **Wood Badge Holder** and currently registered with the BSP.
 - Must be physically fit for rigid survival activities.
 - Must be a registered Merit Badge Counselor and Board of Review Member.

- Must be endorsed by the Council Scout Executive or Regional Youth Development Officer.
5. Registration fees, transportation, and other incidental expenses are chargeable against Scouting Funds, Local Funds, MOOE, or SEF, subject to availability and standard accounting and auditing rules.
 6. Interested and qualified personnel must submit their names to the Division BSP Coordinator for endorsement. The final list of participants must be submitted to the Regional Office.

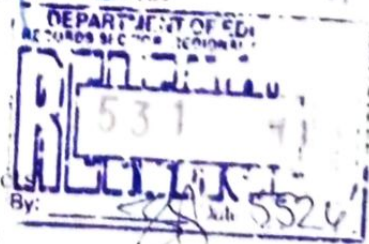


1. Aims and objectives:
