**PARTICIPATION IN THE CITY ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICE  
(CENRO) ENVIRONMENT MONTH CELEBRATION ACTIVITIES**

1. Attached is a communication from the City Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO), Calbayog City, inviting selected elementary and secondary schools to participate in the Environment Month Celebration this June 2026 with the theme, "Ending Global Plastic Pollution," through cultural and art competitions, including poster-making, environmental quiz, and spotlight competitions.
2. In accordance with DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026 and consistent with the principles of Authority, Responsibility, and Accountability (AuRA), the decision to participate in the said activity shall be subject to the discretion and sound judgment of the respective School Heads, taking into consideration the welfare of learners, availability of resources, safety and security measures, and the attainment of school and division targets.
3. School Heads are reminded that participation in the activity shall be voluntary and shall not result in the disruption of classes, learning delivery, assessment activities, or other official school undertakings. Appropriate arrangements shall be made to ensure continuity of instruction and the protection of instructional time in accordance with existing DepEd policies.
4. Further, any participation of learners and school personnel shall be subject to existing rules on parental consent, safety protocols, supervision of learners, and the proper utilization of school resources. No school funds shall be expended unless authorized under applicable government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Advisory are desired.

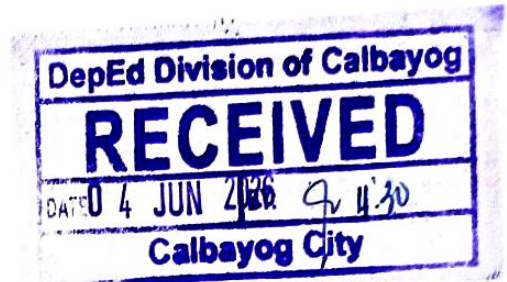
