2. The competition is open to **Junior High School and Senior High School students (Grades 7-12)** who are interested in global trade, business, entrepreneurship, or logistics. It aims to nurture the entrepreneurial spirit and enhance the marketing talents of Filipino youth.
3. Key details of the event are as follows:
 - **Participant Goal:** JA Philippines invites 500 students (in teams of 2) from Region VIII.
 - **Incentive:** Winning teams from the local competition will represent the Philippines in the **Regional Finals in Singapore** with all expenses covered.
 - **Timeline:** Mentoring sessions will occur between July and August, with the Regional Finals scheduled for **August 2026**.
