**DISTRIBUTION AND TURNOVER OF TELEVISION SETS FROM THE PROVINCIAL
GOVERNMENT OF SAMAR**

1. The Schools Division Office of Calbayog City informs all concerned that the **Provincial Government of Samar** will conduct the **turnover and distribution of Television (TV) sets** to identified recipient teachers as indicated in **Annex A** of this Memorandum.
2. The turnover ceremony shall be held at **Tandaya Hall, Catbalogan City, Samar, at 1:00 in the afternoon on August 11, 2026**, and shall be graced by **Hon. Sonny Angara, Secretary of the Department of Education**.
3. All identified teacher-recipients are **required to attend the turnover ceremony** and shall be accompanied by their respective **School Heads**. The School Heads are requested to ensure the attendance and proper coordination of their respective teacher-recipients.
4. The concerned School Heads and teacher-recipients are likewise reminded to observe proper coordination and arrangements for the **transportation and hauling of the TV sets from Catbalogan City to Calbayog City and subsequently to their respective school stations**.
5. DepEd personnel who render services **beyond regular working hours, including weekends and holidays**, in connection with the preparation and conduct of this activity may be granted **Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC)** and may subsequently avail themselves of **Compensatory Time Off (CTO)**, subject to the provisions of **CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004**, entitled *Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered*, and other existing DepEd policies, rules, and regulations.
6. **Travel expenses and expenses for the hauling of the TV sets** from Catbalogan City to Calbayog City and to the respective school stations, incurred in connection with this activity, shall be charged against the **School MOOE, SEF, or other available funds**, subject to the availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. For information, guidance, and strict compliance of all concerned.
