**SUBMISSION OF SCHOOL ICT PLAN (CY 2026–2027) AND NARRATIVE
REPORT (CY 2025–2026) THROUGH DIGITAL ASSISTANCE SERVICES HUB
(DASH)**

1. In line with the Schools Division Office's institutional commitment to digital transformation and the streamlined monitoring of school-level operational accomplishments, this Office mandates the submission of the **School ICT Plan for Calendar Year (CY) 2026–2027** and the **Narrative Report for Calendar Year (CY) 2025–2026**.
2. To advance our objective of a paperless and highly accountable reporting workflow, all submissions shall be made exclusively through the new **ICT PLAN** module in DASH (www.sdocalbayog.net). The submission window is open until **5:00 PM on August 31, 2026**.
3. The required data and forms are to be accomplished by the designated School ICT Coordinator and to be approved by the School Head thru their respective DASH Accounts. Submissions must follow the standards below:
 - **School ICT Plan (CY 2026–2027):** Outlining strategic technology integration, infrastructure development plans, and targeted capability building for teaching and non-teaching personnel.
 - **Narrative Report (CY 2025–2026):** Detailing accomplishments, localized innovations, best practices, and technical challenges encountered during the previous cycle, complete with means of verification (MOVs).
4. The Information Technology Officer (ITO) and the IT Unit staff shall directly monitor the progress and completeness of all school compliance within the

system dashboard during the submission period. School Heads are advised to coordinate closely with the IT Unit helpdesk should any system-related concerns arise.
